On the day, your child can come to school dressed in a themed outfit for the period of history that they are studying. You do not have to buy a new costume for the event, although you can if you wish. We would encourage you to create the costume using clothes that you already have at home.

Attendance

This week, I would like to remind you about punctuality. When children are late to school, even by a few minutes, it becomes much more difficult for them to pick up the thread of learning for the day. Each teacher sets early work for children to help consolidate learning from the current or previous week. If your child doesn't access this, they are not receiving this important opportunity to start the day.



Last week, we made a very positive start to the term with attendance - whole school attendance was 94.7% and 2 classes together took the top spot with 99% attendance: 6MD and 5H. Well done to those classes!
