This week, we have been reviewing numbers up to 10 by counting from various starting points and using different manipulatives to represent each number in multiple ways .

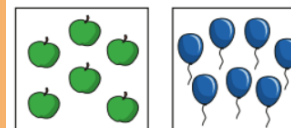

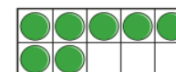
